One of the most touching YouTube videos I've ever seen one in which a deaf woman receives new technology to he her hearing. She hears her husband's voice for the first tim — and her own, too — and bursts into tears of overwhelmin joy. It must have been like an immovable wall between he and her loved ones came tumbling down.

We are all like this woman, to some degree. We believe in the presence of God's love, but we can't hear Him. We can speak well about Him. The deaf man who can't speak proper in the Gospel today is an image of what God wants us to experience again and again. Jesus takes the man aside to private place away from the crowd, touches his ears ar tongue, and says, "**Ephphata**!" The man's ears are opener and he speaks clearly. Contact with Christ has this effect of us.

This experience happens to us in our baptism, almost exactl It happens to us in the liturgy. It happens in our privat prayer. It happens when we hear the voice of God in ou conscience. The more we engage these privileged channels of Jesus' healing, the more we are empowered to hear an speak of the presence of God's perfect love.
